

## Brooklyn Book Bodega Internships

Internships operate on a seasonal calendar for 12 weeks and require a minimum of 10 hours per week. Application deadlines differ for each term:

Fall Internships: September – December	Applications due July 15
Spring Internships: January – May	Applications due November 1
Summer Internships: June – August	Applications due April 1

To Apply: Send resume and cover letter to <u>info@brooklynbookbodega.org</u> with the subject line "Internship" and the season you are applying for. In the body of your email, indicate where you are enrolled as a student, and whether you will be receiving course credit.

General responsibilities include, but are not limited to:

- Sorting, stamping, and selecting books for distribution
- Supporting education and public program initiatives and book giveaways through event assistance and materials management (during and outside working hours)
- Data input and program tracking; website analysis
- Marketing, newsletter, social media, and educational content creation
- Research and reports

Must be a flexible team player with communication skills and an interest in community service. Strong oral and writing skills are required.

Compensation: Internships are unpaid

Internships are a mix of in person at our Brooklyn Navy Yard Book Hub and remote. Interns must be vaccinated as per <u>Key to NYC</u>.
